


ESTHER WERTHEIMER'S

PRESS RELEASE 2011

November 2009 Esther Wertheimer was in Italy. She was invited by the City of Florence to participate in the 2009 Florence Biennale with her sculptures; "**Invictus**, **Five Dancers**, and **Madre Gambe Incrociate**" were on display. At the end of the exhibition, the Biennale awarded her the "Gold Medal of Lorenzo il Magnifico" and a certificate to honor her career and work.

Esther Wertheimer was chosen as "artist of the month" by Artists Registry. In November 09, "Palm Beach Illustrated" Magazine featured a one-page article on Esther Wertheimer and her colored bronze sculptures.

On September 4th, 2009 Esther Wertheimer was invited to attend the 4th Annual "100% Pure Florida" Exhibition that was held at the Fifth Avenue Art Gallery in Melbourne, Florida. Wertheimer's colored sculpture, "**Madre Gambe Incrociate**", won best in show out of 99 artists and 277 pieces of art. She was awarded a solo exhibition for the month of June 2010. Her opening reception debuted on Friday, June 4th, where art enthusiasts and fans met Wertheimer and her artwork while she lectured about the history of her career and the creative process of her famous colored sculptures.

Hurdles/Leap at the AWAA Group Show

In Washington, Esther Wertheimer is also a part of an organization called ArtsWest Artist Association. Recently they held a group show for all the members. Wertheimer's colored sculpture "Hurdles/Leap" was featured at the show. As the group show is over, the sculpture is now located in the Gunnar Nordstrom gallery in Bellevue, Washington.

Esther Wertheimer's sculpture, "**Invictus**", was accepted and won the Honorary Nathaniel Kaz cash award at the 67th Annual Audubon Exhibition, which was held at the Salmagundi Club in New York, New York. The sculpture was on display through the month of October 2009.

Wertheimer had exhibited in the **Nina Torres Fine Art-Art Basel Miami** show on December 1st to 20th, 2010 which featured International Biennale artists.

Also on December 1st, 2010, Wertheimer was a part of the **Red Dot Art Fair** in Miami, FL where she had three of her colored works on display.

In April 2011, Wertheimer had a one person exhibition at the **Sher Gallery** in Aventura, FL. Esther debuted her newest colored sculptures and one of her monumental sculptures, Airborn. She has sold five sculptures at this exhibition.
