Wertheimer to Exhibit Sculptures at Boca Pointe Country Club

Boca Raton, Florida (February 3, 2009) – Internationally known sculptor Esther Wertheimer will present “The Energy and the Ecstasy Exhibition on Sculpture” on Saturday, February 28 and Sunday, March 1 from 10:00 am to 8:00 pm. at Boca Pointe Country Club, 7144 Boca Pointe Drive in west Boca Raton. The display will be open to the public.

Known for her colored bronze sculptures that “look and feel like glass,” Wertheimer’s pieces seem to float in the air as they reflect the vibrant spirit of the

human form. So elegant, graceful and fluid are her dancing figures they seem to do everything but breathe. Thirty of her pieces, ranging in size from 8” to 30”, will be on display.

“Airborn,” a mother holding her child up high, will soon be installed in front of the newly built Port Saint Lucie Civic Center. The second of Wertheimer’s sculptures to grace that city, her life-sized bronze sculpture “Born Free” currently stands in front of the City Hall and welcomes visitors to Port St. Lucie.

Wertheimer recently showed her sculptures in two China exhibits, the Shanghai Art Fair and the Shanghai Sculpture Space Museum, where she represented Canada and showed six of her figures.

Over the next year, she will be showing her work in several exhibits from Miami to New York and has been invited to participate in Florence, Italy’s upcoming Biennale, a most honored and important World Art Fair. In 2010, Wertheimer will travel back to Shanghai to exhibit her work in the Shanghai 2010 Art Exposition.

About Esther Wertheimer

Wertheimer has 34 monumental sculptures worldwide. Fourteen of her large sculptures are displayed in Japan in City Halls, Performing Art Centers, Museums and Parks. From 101 applicants, she recently won a commission to do a nine-foot sculpture for the Washington DC East Gate Condominium. The sculpture of four figures entitled *Celebration*, was installed in 2007.

Born in Poland, Esther Wertheimer has lived most of her life in Montreal. She maintains studios in Montreal and Boca Raton, Florida as well as returning to Italy for several months each year to work in the artists’ colony of Pietrasanta. She also travels extensively to other cities where her works are exhibited.
